

Cairo, Egypt, November 17 (Infosplusgabon) - Here are more results from the first-leg, first-round qualifying matches played on Friday for the 2019 Under-23 African Nations Cup (AFCON), which will be hosted by Egypt.

Players born 1 January, 1997, or later are eligible to participate in the competition. A total of eight teams qualify to play in the final tournament, including Egypt who qualify automatically as hosts.

These matches also serve as the first stage of the CAF qualifiers for the 2020 Summer Olympics men's football tournament in Japan.

Winners after the second leg will join Mali, Morocco, Nigeria, Senegal, Cote d'Ivoire, Tunisia, Sierra Leone, Algeria, Gabon Congo, Zambia, Zimbabwe, and South Africa (all of whom drew bye into the second round) as well as Libya and Angola (which qualified by walk over).

Libya walked over Gambia and Angola over Namibia.
