

***Cape Town, South Africa, October 11 (Infosplusgabon) - FIFA has confirmed that a goal scored by South African goalkeeper, Oscarine Masuluke, is one of three contenders for the global goal of the year award, to handed out in London on 23 October.***

Baroka FC goalkeeper, Masuluke, made headlines around the world with his extra-time wonder goal against Orlando Pirates, one of Africa's top teams, last November.

His bicycle kick from the edge of the area earned his side a magnificent 1-1 draw at the Peter Mokaba Stadium.

He becomes the first African and goalkeeper to be nominated.

The other nominees are Oliver Giroud (Arsenal) and Deyna Castellanos (Venezuela's girls U-17).
